The Mellon Public Scholars program introduces graduate students to the intellectual and practical aspects of public humanities. It does so through a two-credit seminar in Spring quarter, faculty mentorship, and a community-based project over the summer. Applicants do not need to have a project or faculty member in mind, and their research may not immediately relate to community scholarship. All that is required is an interest in public humanities and enrollment in a PhD program in the humanities, arts, or humanistic social sciences.
